- Spring 2014 Max Falque edited "L'eau entre réglementation et marché" (Johanet, 313 pp.) a collection of essays dealing with non point source pollution, tradable permits, groundwater governance. A preface by P-F. Ténrière-Buchot and a postface of M. Guespereau, CEO of Agence de l'Eau, emphasize the interest of this book.
- Eventually, we printed a new booklet updating our accomplishment since 1992.
